Special Notice to Passengers Traveling with Minor Children

If you are a single parent traveling with children, you may be requested to provide proof from the parent not traveling that they are aware of your plans.

Some examples of when this may be required:

- * Your spouse is not traveling with you
- * You are divorced or separated
- * Other parent is deceased
- * Grandparents traveling with their grandchildren

For any of these or similar situations, you should plan on carrying a notarized statement from the unaccompanying parent(s) that advises of their consent for you and the child to travel. In addition, we also recommend adding a statement that allows you to make medical decisions on behalf of the child.

If you have sole custody of the child, then a court statement to this effect would be needed.

You should verify the travel requirements, and forward any questions you may have to the embassy for the countries to which you will be traveling. This information can be found in the trip guide of your confirmation materials.
